## Strengths

At Orchard Ridge we are grounded in collaborative teaming to meet students' academic and social emotional needs. We are extremely focused on consistent coherent instruction, we are very clear on what all students should know and need to be able to do. All teachers turn in the lesson plans in advance for feedback to ensure all grade level standards are met and that our instruction is rigorous. We monitor student learning of the standards and adjust our instruction so students can learn at higher levels. We know that partnerships with our families are essential to our students' success.

## **Progress**

We are extremely excited to share that we met and exceeded our literacy goals for all students in both the foundational K-2 assessment 74% which was our goal and the 3-5 MAP assessment 38% which was the goal. We also exceeded our proficiency rates from our initial goal, our African American students grew by 11% and our English Language Learners grew by 13% from the start of the year. We are so proud of our students' hard work!

## **Area for Growth**

Orchard Ridge staff will continue to strengthen our lessons for the literacy block for continued growth in reading, aligning our lessons with guided reading groups to carry over skills learned towards independence. We believe this will accelerate our students' academic growth. As equity will be a focus for us next year, we will analyze our results for all students as well as our focus groups, students identified as African American as well as English Language Learners.

## **Vision Connection**

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 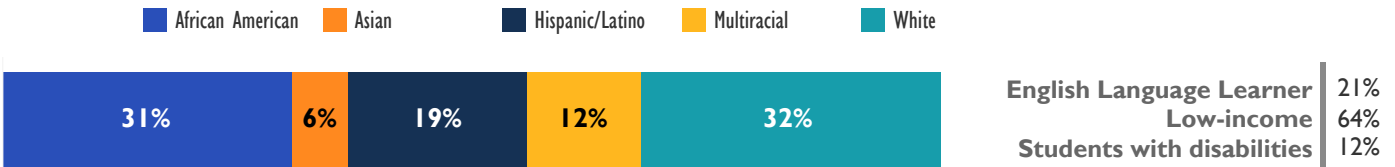

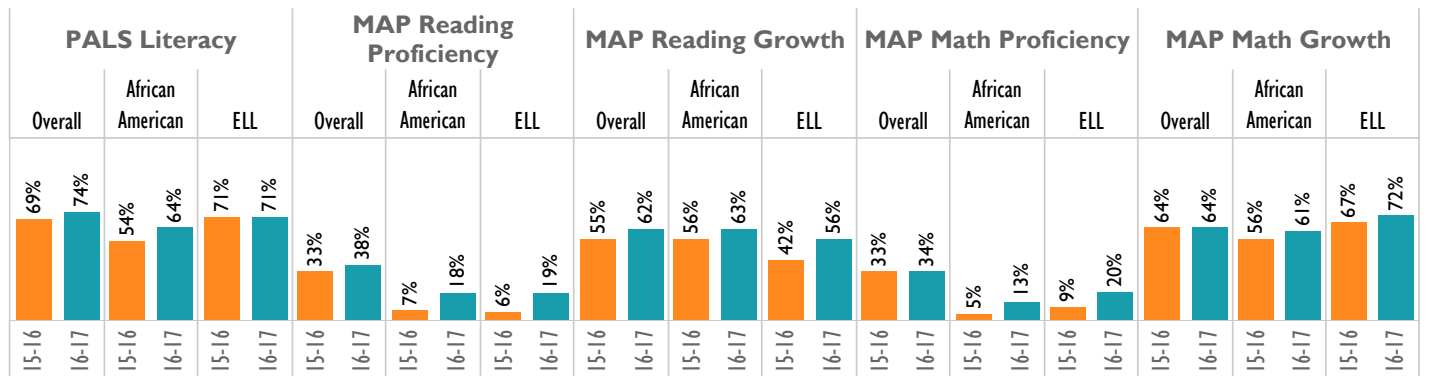

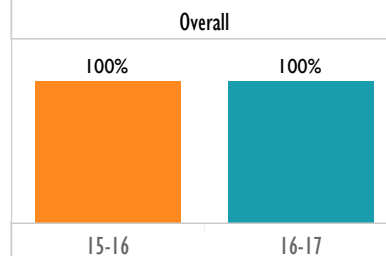
## Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
